

# Charfield Village Plan 2012

## QUICK SUMMARY

Answers given by **over 50%** of the 582 households who completed a questionnaire, either relating to concerns or problems, improvements/developments they would like to see, things they think are necessary or important, or activities they would like to take part in, are summarised below. All percentages are out of **582**.

- **65%** think the **public toilets** in the village are necessary
- **63%** think the layby near Junction 14 used informally for car sharing should be made into a more **formal car share facility**
- **62%** have concerns regarding **traffic speed** on the main road through the village - Wotton Road
- **61%** said their **broadband speed** is either poor or so poor it affects their use
- **60%** think **dog fouling** is a problem in Charfield
- **60%** said their household's needs would be met by more **public transport services to Bristol/Cribbs**  
**54%** said their household's needs would be met by more **public transport services to Bristol City Centre**
- **58%** think there should be a **permanent pedestrian crossing** in the New Street/Wotton Road/Station Road junction area
- **53%** would be interested in joining a **Neighbourhood Watch Scheme**
- The following 11 facilities were rated as being **"Very important to Charfield"** by over 50% of households:
  - **95%** Post Office
  - **93%** School
  - **90%** Shops
  - **82%** Playing Field (Children's Play Areas)
  - **77%** Playing Field (Football/Cricket Area)
  - **77%** Memorial Hall
  - **67%** Petrol Station
  - **66%** Pubs
  - **54%** Churches
  - **53%** Playing Field (Tennis Court)
  - **52%** Playing Field (Skate Park)
